- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges

WIS 20 Interchange Reconstruction Project Update

As part of Wisconsin Department of Transportation's (WisDOT) WIS 20 Interchange reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the next phase of this project:

Crews are preparing to switch traffic onto the new lanes for I-94 EAST (SB). Additionally concrete patching operations on WIS 20 will require scheduled closures.

All closures are weather dependent and subject to change.

Upcoming closures the week of September 14:

- WIS 20 under I-94 will be reduced to one lane in each direction between the frontage roads starting Monday, September 14 at 6 a.m. through Friday, September 18 at 6 a.m.
- I-94 WEST (NB) entrance ramp from WIS 20 is scheduled to close to traffic Monday, September 14 at 9 a.m. through Thursday, September 17 at 6 a.m.

Detour:

→ Traffic on WIS 20 will be directed to use East Frontage Road north to County K to access I-94 WEST (NB).

Crews are preparing to switch traffic to the new I-94 EAST (SB) lanes over WIS 20 and will require intermittent lane closures during the traffic switch.
