Programs for Adults

Jessica Michna as Helen Keller - February 1st at 1:00 pm. Jessica presents her portrayal of the life of Helen Keller, the first blind, deaf woman to receive her Bachelor of Arts degree. Jessica's presentations never fail to entertain and enlighten her audience as her powerful biographical performances bring women from the past to life.
