# 2014 WIS 20 Interchange Reconstruction Updates

As part of Wisconsin Department of Transportation's (WisDOT) WIS 20 Interchange reconstruction, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the project.

All closures are weather dependent and subject to change.

Overnight Full Freeway closure scheduled Wednesday, November 19, 2014:

Crews will require an overnight full freeway closure of I-94 WEST (NB) and I-94 EAST (SB) between WIS 20 and County K, to strip form work from the County Highway C Bridge.

The closure is currently scheduled on Wednesday, November 19, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., with a contingency of Thursday night.

## **Detour:**

- → Traffic on I-94 WEST (NB) will be directed to exit at WIS 20 and turn right (east) onto WIS 20. Turn left (north) on East Frontage Road and continue to the County K entrance ramp to I-94 WEST (NB).
- → Traffic on I-94 EAST (SB) will be directed to exit at County K, turn right (west) to West Frontage Road. Turn left (south) on West Frontage Road and continue to the WIS 20 entrance ramp to I-94 EAST (SB).

In addition, there will be a few exit and entrance ramps closed to/from I-94 WEST (NB) and I-94 EAST (SB) during this work.
